Letter from the Chairmen

First off: thank you all for coming to NordicFuzzCon 2013! A year ago, this convention seemed like a dream; now, we are excited and proud that so many of you participate and make the dream a reality. We aim for you to have the best possible con experience, and that, when you leave, you leave with a wish to return for a future NFC convention.

As many of you know, NFC originated from a furmeet held in Stockholm in May last year. Over two days, some 40-odd fuzzballs from Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Poland, and the US got together for bowling, a picnic, and a fursuit outing in Stockholm old town. After the meet, we received many positive and encouraging comments. The question arose whether it was possible to expand the meet into a convention, and that we did. While planning started already in May, the public kick-off came when we began handing out flyers at Eurofurence 18.

Finding a suitable hotel for the convention was a time-consuming process. We investigated and discarded around 30 hotels, motels, and similar establishments before stumbling upon our current choice. The management here at Quality Hotel Winn turned out to be very accommodating, and this felt like the purrfect home for our new con.

The convention theme was set over a dinner in Linköping. We had narrowed everything down to the impossible choice between either Vikings or Pirates. Somebody suggested we should instead combine the two ideas, and thus the theme Vikings vs. Pirates was born.

The opening of the booking system was a hectic time. A few bugs manifested themselves shortly before opening, and we spent the final hours before launch in a room at the University in Linköping, busily fixing the problems.

Following those initial bumps, everything has progressed smoothly. When our Fur Affinity ticket raffle ended just before Christmas, we had about 80 bookings. This already exceeded our initial expectations of 60 - 70 participants. To get exclusive access to the hotel we needed 100 attendees on the 8th of January, a goal we met with a few hours to spare. As of printing this text we have over 160 attendees from 14 different countries, an amazing turnout for a first-year furry convention.

We would like to thank you once again for believing in us and choosing to attend this first ever Nordic-FuzzCon!

Convention Rules

Before you run off and have fun at the convention, we ask that you familiarise yourself with the following rules.

- Only attendees are allowed in the hotel during the convention days. To show that you have a valid registration you have to wear your conbadge visible at all times.
- Please respect other attendees and their privacy. Stop means stop!
- If you damage anything you are liable for it.
- Everything shown in public areas has to fit a general audience. That goes for artwork, clothing and costumes.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere inside the building.
- Drink responsibly. You are always liable for what you do, even if you are intoxicated.
- The consumption of food or non-alcoholic drinks purchased from outside of the hotel is only permitted in your private hotel room.
- Please keep noise levels in hotel rooms low after midnight.
- All weapons, look-alikes, replicas, tools and toys must be approved by must be approved by ConOps
- No mock fights without special permission from security.
- You agree that videos and pictures taken of you can be used in non-profit publications without release or compensation.
- Photographing in the Dealers Den is prohibited. Cameras are not permitted at all in the Art Show.

This is a short version of the Rules of Conduct you agreed to during the registration process. Please be aware that this overview does not cover all rules and that all decisions will be based on the full rules as given on our webpage: <http://www.nordicfuzzcon.org/Home/Rules>

Failure to comply with these rules may result in a stern talking to (in less severe cases), expulsion from the convention and the hotel grounds (in severe cases), or being reported to the official authorities (in very severe cases).



Hotel Information

Food

The **Valhalla Breakfast Buffet** will be open from 08:00 to 11:00 Friday to Sunday. On the early arrival and late departure mornings, the buffet is open during the hotel's standard hours from 07:00 to 10:00. For attendees staying at the hotel, access to the breakfast buffet is included **for free!** Those not staying at the hotel can still join, but are required to pay 125 SEK. The hotel will also offer a **Pirate Feast Dinner Buffet** from 19:00 to 21:30 Thursday to Saturday. Access to the dinner buffet costs 115 SEK.

A selection of alcoholic beverages can be purchased at the hotel's bar. The bar will be moved to the restaurant during its opening hours, but will otherwise be at the hotel's reception. Service ends at 02:00.

If you are staying at the hotel you can also use your convention badge to order food and drinks. The items will be added to your hotel registration and you will be required to pay for them when checking out. If your room is undamaged when checking out, your room deposit can go towards covering your bill.

Internet Access

Wi-fi internet is free for all attending the convention! Just look for the network **WLAN Zone – The Cloud**. Upon connection, your internet browser should direct you to a login page. Register there to get a Cloud account, which you will then use to get access. If you already have a Cloud account, use it to login.

Sauna

For those staying at the hotel, there is a sauna available at the premises. (PS. *We do not recommend using the sauna in your fursuit!*) The sauna is open from 17:00 to 23:00 every day.

Good to Know!

- The shopping center Hange Centrum is right nearby and ready for pillaging! (as long as you pay of course). It is located to the left of the hotel from the front entrance.
- If you are in need of cash, a cash machine (ATM) is nearby, located besides SEB Bank. Walk out the front entrance of the hotel and head left. No treasure map needed!
- Convention staff can be recognized by their red lanyards and staff t-shirts, while security can be recognized by their black lanyards. Unless otherwise preoccupied, they are happy to assist you if needed.
- Summer time is upon us here in Scandinavia. On March 31st at 02:00 (night to Sunday), you will need to turn your clock an hour forward.



Getting the Most Out of Your First Furry Convention

Greetings, fellow Furrries, and welcome to NordicFuzzCon! Denna person använder en olicensierad översättningsprogram och bör hängas av hans inälvor!

For many of you this is going to be your first visit to a Furry convention. We all want you to have the time of your life and to come away with fantastic memories of your first foray into this amazing world that we have created for ourselves. There are a few things that newcomers may find puzzling, or which may present an unforeseen hazard that could ruin your fun. Please take a moment to tread through this list so that you can navigate the convention waters like the fine Viking seafarers of old.

Fursuits: This is the unique signature of a Furry convention. Everyone loves fursuits! They're cute and bouncy and playful and always bring a smile. There are some points of etiquette that bear repeating, especially for those who have not dealt with them before.

They cannot see very well. Their field of vision is extremely limited. Please give them extra space when they are passing, warn them if there is a hazard in their path (like a small child) that they likely cannot see, and offer to give them a hand going up and down stairs. Most importantly, as excited as you may be to see them, *do not jump on them!* The person inside does not know that you are coming and there have been serious injuries in the past caused by people who did not realize that the fursuit-target was not ready to be assaulted.

They are expensive. Fursuits can cost anywhere from €300 to €9000 and even higher. Please do not run up to hug one if you have cotton candy all over your hands or are carrying a glass of red wine. The fur also does not grow back, so as much as it is tempting, do not scratch at a fursuit, or if you cannot resist, do so very gingerly to avoid damaging the pelt.

They can be uncomfortably hot. Fursuiters have a universal gesture to indicate that they are becoming overheated, which is a very dangerous situation. That gesture is to fan the face or the mouth of the suit with the hands. If a fursuiter is doing

that, or otherwise just does not look right, do not be afraid to ask if the person needs help. It is a universally-accepted courtesy to give fursuiters priority access on elevators or in any sort of choke points where they may have trouble getting to a private area to cool down.

Other guests: The chances are good that there are going to be people around, namely other guests of the venue, who are not going to be part of the convention. Please treat them with courtesy and respect, and if they do not want to join in our festivities, respect that and do not pressure them. We want them to come away with a favorable impression of our fandom so try to be a good ambassador. This is a good time to bring up an old myth that "Furry conventions are places where you can just run up and hug anyone!" This sounds very nice, but it is not true, and in some instances is a good way to get yourself a black eye. Furry conventions are very friendly, but like any social gathering, certain societal norms are expected to be followed.

The 6-2-1 rule: This was developed by an American physician, Dr. Robert Passavoy, with many years of convention experience. Dr. Passavoy's recommendation is:

Six hours of sleep, minimum. We know that you are having a ball and don't want to take the time out to sleep, but you must. We promise you that we'll still be here when you wake up.

Two good meals, minimum. Poptarts are not meals. Red Bull is not a meal. Good, healthy food, consisting of protein, fiber, dairy products, and fruit/vegetable matter is crucial to maintaining your health. There have been instances, many of them, of first-year convention attendees having so much fun that they have literally *forgotten to eat*. We usually discover them after the second or third day when the ambulance shows up for them.

One shower, minimum, and if you are a fursuiter, a shower every time you take off your suit. This is sometimes excused on a societal level, but for the most part, if you do not shower once a day and put on fresh clothing, you are going to *stink* and you may find your popularity suffering.

"But, Uncle Kage," you say, "I can easily go on two hours sleep and a Coke-Zero and a pack of Smarties are all I need!" Take it from an old convention organizer. Your body needs rest in order to rejuvenate itself. Your body needs fuel in order to keep going. If you deprive yourself of either, your body is going to become weak, and your immune system is going to likewise become weak. Here you are now in a place surrounded by hundreds, maybe even thousands of people from all over the continent and all over the world, and they are all bringing along their local bacteria and viruses. You are going to be exposed to the biotic horror for several days and if your immune system is not up to the task, you are going to come down with the dreaded **CON CRUD**. Do not let your first Furry convention experience be ruined by getting sick and miserable.

Con Book/Schedule/etc: Your convention staff have worked hard to put together a program, and they have no doubt given you at least a printout of what they are offering and perhaps even a really neat con book that is crammed full of useful information and neat stuff and amazing things, and if you are like most people you are going to throw it on the floor when you get to your room and never look at it. Please take a moment to look it over. You might even learn something before your through! About 80% of the questions that are asked of con staff are answered with, "It's in the con book. Didn't you read it?"

Personal safety. For reasons of decorum, the less said about this, the better; however, if you are a young person and you meet with someone that shares your interest, and a friendship develops that blossoms rapidly into something deeper, by all means, please, protect yourself. You know what I mean. We want to see you here for years in the future.

The Staff: Last, and far from least, is the convention staff. Take it from me: these are people who have given up a lot of their personal holiday time and almost all of their spare time in the last month or more, and have endured many hardships, disappointments, tense moments and downright catastrophes all for the singular purpose of making sure that you have a good time. They are indeed the best and most generous of Furrries. Be grateful to them, buy them a drink, make sure they get enough to eat themselves, and above all, try not to make their job more difficult than it already is. Follow the rules that have been set down; I can guarantee you that every rule, no matter how senseless it may look, is in place because *someone tried it at one time*. The staff is under an enormous amount of pressure and while they try their best to keep up a smile, if it should happen that they become irritable or seem rude, please give them your understanding.

There are many more things that I could say, but since you've already thrown this book onto the floor of your room and aren't going to read any of what I've just written, I'll just say: Welcome to the convention! Enjoy yourself, be safe, be happy, and revel in the unique and frolicsome world that is Furry Fandom!

Guests of Honour: DivineVixen & Snout

NordicFuzzCon is happy to introduce you to our guests of honour: DivineVixen and Snout, two of the driving forces behind the early development of the furry fandom in Europe.

They started the sci-fi and furry themed MUCK (an online text-based roleplaying game) Sociopolitical Ramifications (SPR) in 1994, which is still running to this day. On the same server they hosted the main mirror for the popular VCL furry art archive, which launched in 1995, ten years before Fur Affinity.

Then in 1996, they arranged and were the chairmen of Eurofurence 2, which took place in Linköping, Sweden. A school acted as the venue, and 35 attendees from different countries in Europe attended. It was the first furry convention ever held in Sweden, so what's more appropriate than they being our very first guests of honour?

We sat down with them for an online interview to learn more about their involvement with the furry community.

An Interview with DivineVixen and Snout

How did you get into the furry fandom?

Snout: Before I knew what a furry was, I watched Animalympics and just loved it, and wanted more. It was more fun and 'mature' than the simple Donald Duck and other kiddie comics. I started out on FIDONet with the specific request to my node that I wanted it to import alt.fan.furry, don't know where I heard the name of that newsgroup though. This was in the olden days when calling long distance (outside my part of Skåne :P) still cost a ton. As many others, I was so excited to find others liking the same things I did.

DivineVixen: I was always attracted to furry characters when I was a kid, and when I in the late 80's read Reed Waller's comic book Omaha the Cat Dancer, I thought it incredibly neat. In 1991, when I for the first time had Usenet directly over the internet instead of over UUCP, and *wow* got to read articles posted the same *day*, I scanned through news groups and was quite amazed when I found a discussion about a certain, from what I had guessed very esoteric and unusual, comic, the group turned out to be alt.fan.furry. After a while, in 1992, I started to roleplay on FurryMUCK, and after two years of that, I started SPR. In late 1994 / early 1995, I got to pass LA at the time for CF6, and that very first furry con was of course the most interesting one. :)

How did you meet each other?

Snout: Unsure if it was the game, or FurryMUCK, first. But we started out as doing a game for an American com-

pany that went belly-up, and I remained in Linköping then.

DivineVixen: Snout sent out a call by bulletin board on FurryMUCK, asking for Swedish furries, and I responded. I think that this was in 1993, and then we met a few times before moving in together in 1995.

How did you end up co-hosting Eurofurence 2? How was the event organized?

Snout: Good question! Hopefully DV knows, since I sort-of think it was suggested it be held there, and we were available to find a venue.

DivineVixen: I believe that the people who ran Eurofurence 1 wanted us to run it since we ran SPR and had been quite visible in different furry contexts.

What are your fondest memories from Eurofurence 2?

Snout: Meeting some new people and faces, and (non furry related) giving people an 'internet room' by pulling 100m of coax cable over another building that was between Martin's apartment and the rented school. Now that was odd.

DivineVixen: Most likely meeting my friends, whom I had not met physically before... and of course how we connected the internet room via a long coaxial cable to a friend's student room. :)

Since you first got into the fandom, how would you say it has progressed since then? What are the major changes?

Snout: When I came in, there weren't many of us, and we were mostly all friendly to each other. Having to stick together since we couldn't really find others with the same interests. From then, it grew. The "AOL time" when tons and tons of immature kids came online was a horror. And then came enough spam to make alt.fan.furry unreadable, at least I thought so. But, people matured, and it's good to see that newcomers - mostly - do have common sense and manners. Now that furry is mainstream enough to have been on several TV episodes, including CSI and Family Guy, it's... both a little too big to really understand, a comfort in numbers, and - not saying this to be elitist or cliquey - it's too large for everyone to get along. Me personally, I really value old timers like me, when I see them on and chat it brings back fuzzy good memories. Then I don't have to feel so alone amongst you young brats. :)

DivineVixen: Progressed?? In my days things were good, and we were all happy. :-) Seriously, there have been many changes. Where the furry fandom all in all has moved from a very internal little thing to something that is recognized as a common subculture like for example science fiction. Technologically, the furry fandom grew very much arm in arm with the spreading of the internet. The MUCKs were very important in the early international fandom, but today the main channels in Sweden seem to be IRC and the WWW sites. Today, there are numerous conventions, numerous new things of which one could only dream and laugh, and even though I often get caught in dreaming of the good old days when no one used more than a byte to transfer a letter, I revel at how things have progressed.

Any particular hopes or wishes for the future of the fandom?

Snout: Grow, don't embarrass us, take over the world. >:)

DivineVixen: That it continues to grow, that it does not become too controlled by any group or interest... that it remains the friendly, inclusive ground for great thought and fun it's always been when at its best.

Finally any words of wisdom for today's young furs?

Snout: Stay in school! :D (Seriously. If there's anything I learned from being a lazy ass, it's that if I had fancy papers I would have so many more options now.) Oh, and if you go buddhist or whatever, send me all your money when you go to the monastery. :)

DivineVixen: One thing that has been a pet peeve with me is how there has always been a group who wants to bring down anything they did not create themselves, or anything that makes them feel less important than before someone else invented it. That is one of the most lethal diseases to wreak havoc on the furry fandom, and perhaps the increased openness has lead to a decrease of the number of such infections. However, with increased openness also comes things like exaggerated restraint, political correctness and self censorship, and in the wake of those, any discipline or subculture can lose its essence. But I have faith in the common sense of 99% of the members of the furry fandom to counter both infighting and down watering. :) Or, in vulpine... Yarf yiff yerf yip!

CHARITY: Södertälje Katthem

Södertälje Katthem (Södertälje Home for Cats) is a non-profit organization of dedicated volunteers devoted to taking care of and finding new homes for homeless cats, first and foremost in the Södertälje area in Stockholm. All cats taken in are given basic medical care, which includes delousing and vaccination. Annually they help relocate 250 - 300 cats, making sure the cats go to good homes.

But times are tough for Södertälje Katthem. Their lease was not extended, and they are being forced to move to a new location. This involves more work and money, making sure their new home is suitable for the cats they take in. To make matters worse, the city has also decided to cut down on the financial support they rely on.

There are several ways in which you can help our feline friends. Throughout the convention, we will be collecting donations from our attendees to help with Södertälje Katthem's relocation. We will also be arranging a lottery with some impressive prizes, as well as having a dedicated charity section in our Art Show, with all proceeds going towards the charity. Let's show them how generous furs can be!

FURSUIT LOUNGE

The fursuit lounge is a safe haven for fursuiters where they can take off their heads, paws and bodies without fear of spectators. If you're tired and need a break from jumping and running around in your fursuit, you can come to the lounge to rest and recuperate. Simple refreshments are available to help fend off dehydration and exhaustion, as well as large fans to help keep the room cool and for the fur to dry more quickly.

For convenience, fursuits can be stored in the fursuit lounge when they are not in use, and there are dedicated racks where fursuits can be hung up to dry. **Note that storage is at your own risk.**

If you suffer a serious fursuit malfunction, there is also a simple fursuit repair station set up for quick repairs. Please inquire with staff if you are also in need of a glue gun.



The Rules of the Lounge:

- This is an area for fursuiters only or their handlers.
- Handlers may enter together with their respective fursuiters.
- Do not take pictures or record video in the lounge.
- Be mindful of other people's property.
- The convention and its staff are not responsible for any property damaged or stolen.

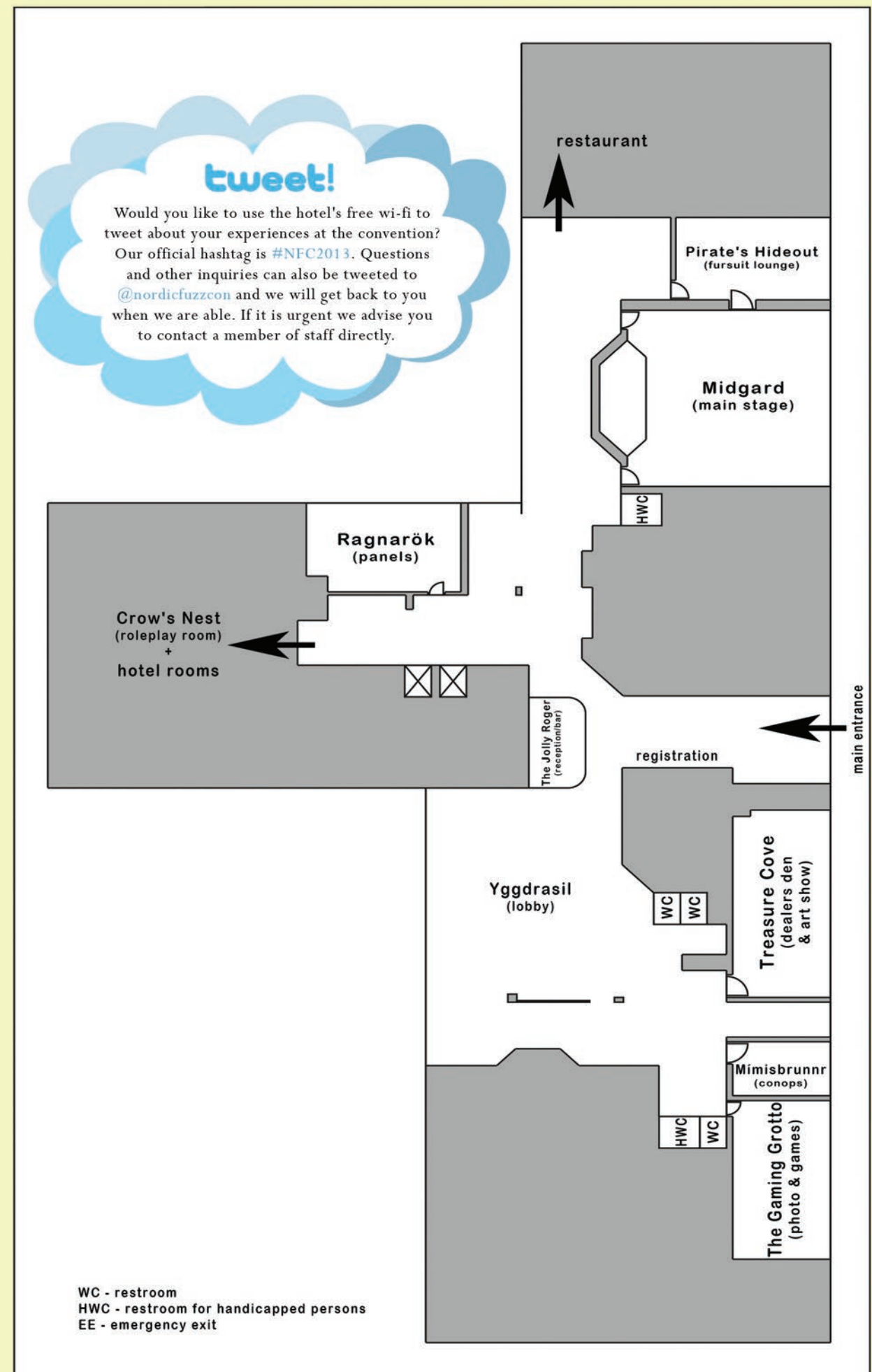
The standard currency in the Dealers Den is Swedish Kronor (SEK), but it's up to the specific dealers if they accept other currencies as well.

In the dealers den you will also find the Art Show, a mini furry art gallery. Here you can register and engage in a silent auction to bid on various limited edition prints and originals. If a bidding sheet is maxed out on a piece, it will move on to the live auction on Saturday. You must then attend the auction and ~~engage in a sword fight to the death~~ outbid your fellow attendees to win back whatever treasure it is you are pursuing. Good luck!

A Note to Dealers

Dealers and contributors to the Art Show are given an hour of exclusive access to the Dealers Den room to set up their tables and hang their art before the room opens for business. This hour is split into two half-hour segments, before and after the "Meet the Guests of Honour" panel, as detailed in the schedule. There is also half-an-hour scheduled after closing for dealers to take down their exhibitions and gather up their goods.

Setup will take place on Friday from 12:30 to 13:00, then resume from 14:00 to 14:30. Teardown will take place on Saturday from 15:00 to 15:30.

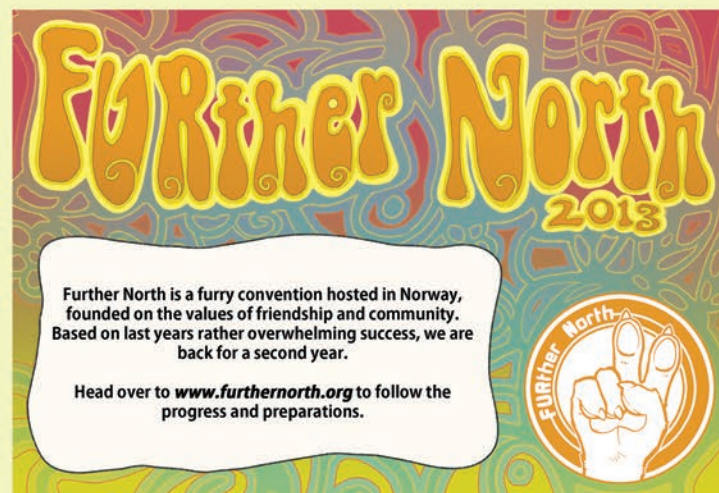
